Schedule 7 Anti-Terrorism & Crime Act 2003. Where an aircraft is employed to carry passengers for reward the owners or agents shall not arrange for it to call at or leave a port in the island for the purpose of disembarking or embarking passengers unless the port is a Designated Port or an examining officer approves the arrangement. Where an Aircraft is employed on a journey otherwise than to carry passengers for reward, the captain of the aircraft shall not permit it to call at or leave a port in the island unless the port is a Designated Port or he gives at least 12 hours notice in writing to a Constable.
